For Becoming One

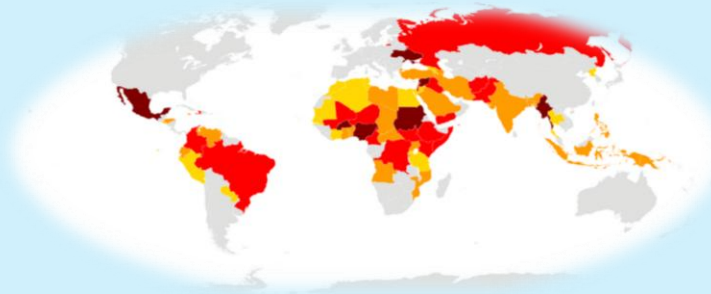
We pray that as we continue our journey to Becoming One we remain hopeful and joyous.
